- 15% of the cost i.e., Rs.150 Crs. is to be met from Board's contribution (State Govt.)
- Project period is 4 years from 2013-14 to 2016-17.
- Project implementing agency is Metro water supply and sewerage Board.
- The project is classified under Urban sector under Municipal Administration & Urban Development Dept.
