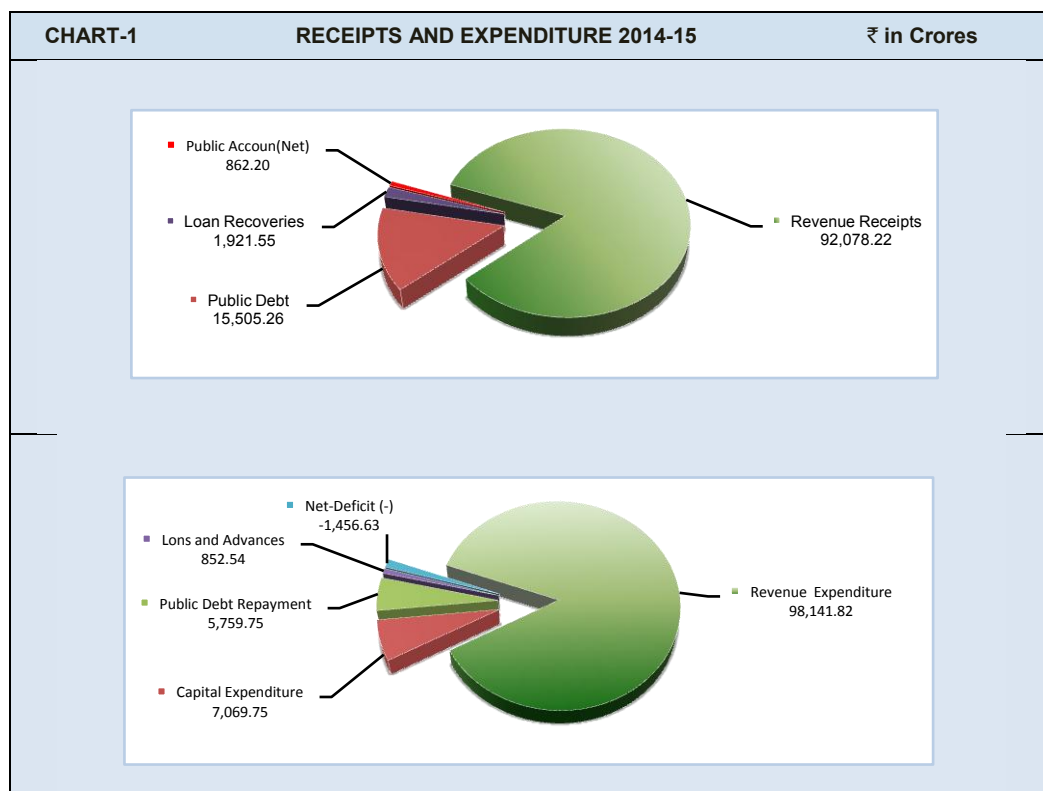

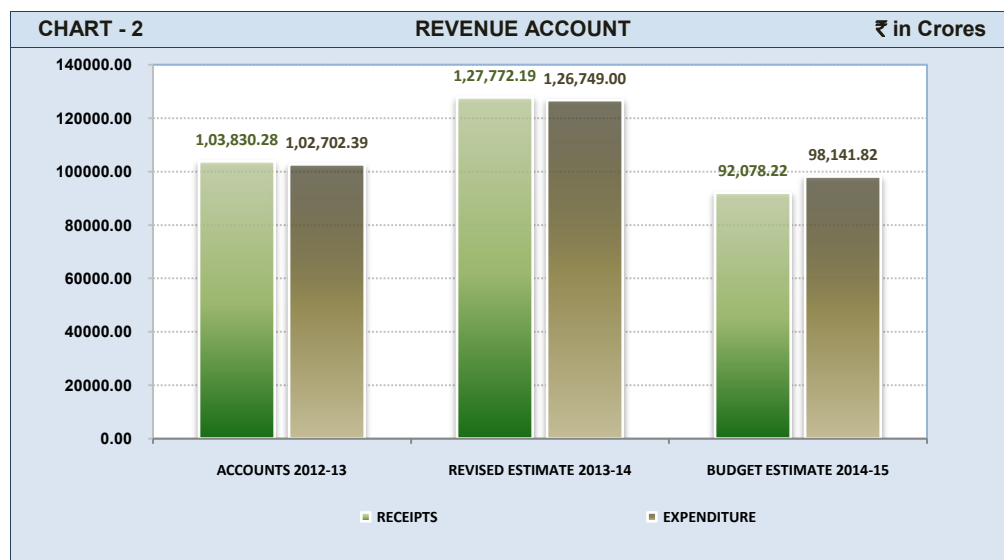

## Revenue Account Receipts and Expenditure

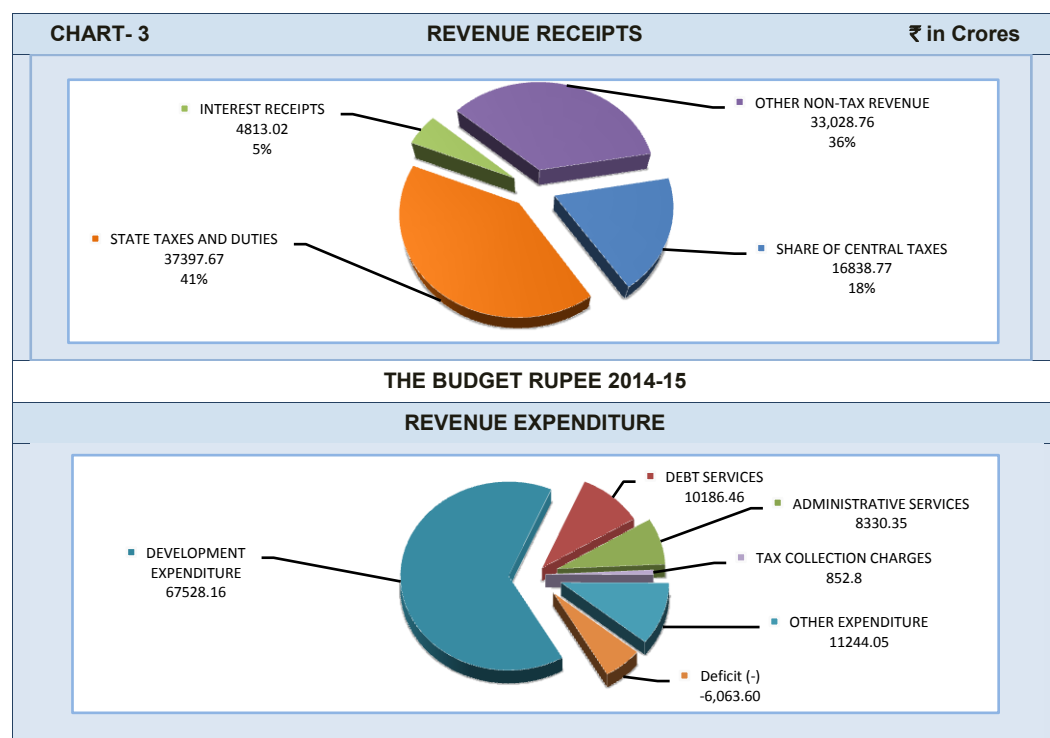

Economic Services

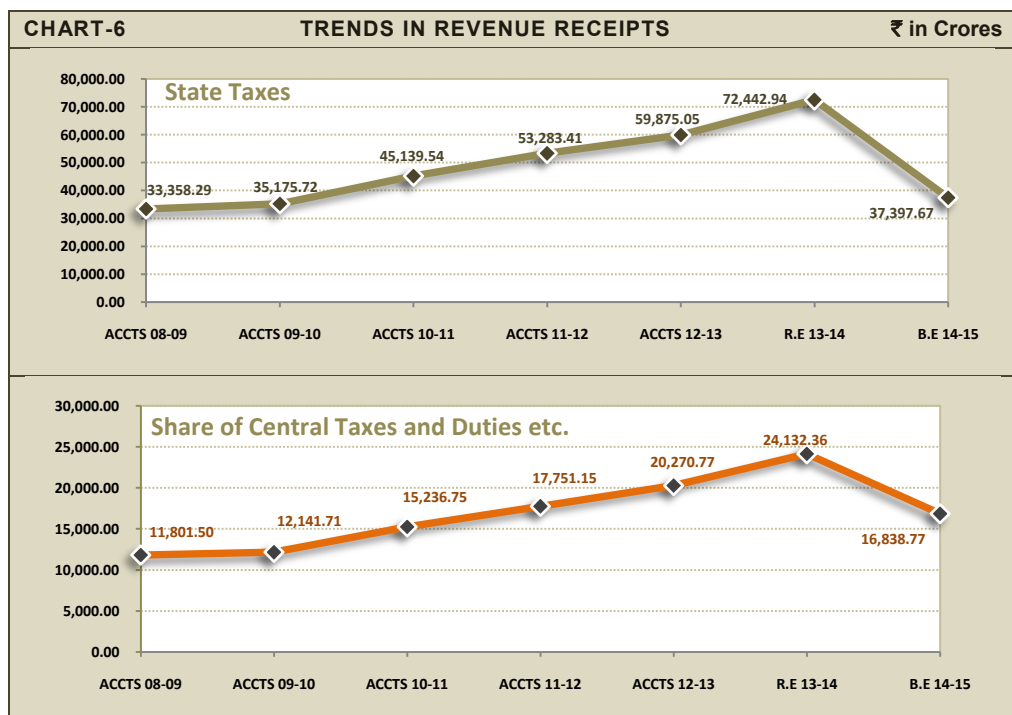
