Statement on Quarterly Review of the trends in receipts and expenditure in relation to the budget at the end of the first quarter of financial year 2023-24

(As required under section 11(1) of the Andhra Pradesh Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2005)

As per Section 11(1) of the Andhra Pradesh Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2005, the Hon'ble Minister for Finance shall review, every quarter, the trends in receipts and expenditure in relation to the budget estimates and place before the Legislature.

I. Receipts

The total Receipts during April-June 2023, is at Rs.85,731.03 crores which is 30.70 per cent of B.E. 2023-24.

A. Revenue Receipts

The Revenue Receipts of Rs.46,112.70 crores which consists of Tax Revenue, Non-Tax Revenue, Share of Central Taxes and Central Grants during April-June 2023 which is 22.36 per cent of Rs.2,06,224.01 crores provided in B.E.2023-24.

a) State's Own Tax Revenue

Receipts under Tax Revenue is Rs.19,458.88 crores during April-June 2023 which is 18.96 percent of Rs.1,02,651.35 crores provided in B.E 2023-24.

b) State's Own Non-Tax Revenue

Non tax revenue receipts during April- June 2023 is Rs.1380.57 crore which is 8.96 per cent of Rs.15,400 crores provided in B.E.2023-24.

c) Devolutions and Grants from Government of India

As per the recommendations of 15th F.C., the devolutions of Share of Central Taxes is 41%. Accordingly, Govt. of India has released the State's Share in Central taxes of Rs.9,573.58 crores during April-June 2023, which is 23.16% of Rs.41,338.02 crores provided in B.E. 2023-24. The State received Rs.15,699.67 crores as Grants from Centre during April-June 2023 which is 33.52% of Rs.46,834.64 crores provided in B.E.2023-24.

B. Capital Receipts

The Capital Receipts consists of Recovery of Loans and Advances, Borrowings & Other Liabilities and Deposits Transactions (Net) shows Rs.39,618.33 crores against the B.E.2023-24 of Rs.73,055.26 crores.

II. Expenditure

The total expenditure during April-June 2023, is at Rs.87,439.81 crores which is 31.31 per cent of B.E. 2023-24.

A. Revenue expenditure: During April-June 2023, the revenue expenditure is Rs.72,719.17 crores which is 31.82% as against the BE 2023-24 of Rs.2,28,540.71 crores. The components under revenue expenditure are salaries, pensions, interest payments, subsidies, maintenance, Navaratnalu, Manifesto Schemes and other grant-in-aid expenditure.

- **B.** Capital expenditure: During April-June 2023, the capital expenditure is Rs.12,669.11 crores which is 40.79% as against Rs.31,061.04 crores provided in BE 2023-24.
- **C. Capital disbursements:** During April-June 2023, the capital disbursements is Rs.1,828.59 crores which is 9.93% as against Rs.18,411.42 crores provided in BE 2023-24.
- **D. Loans and Advances:** During April-June 2023, the Disbursement of Loans and advances is Rs.222.94 crores which is 17.61% as against Rs.1266.10 crores provided in BE 2023-24.

III. Fiscal Indicators:

During April-June 2023, Revenue Deficit is at Rs.26,606.47 crores as against BE 2023-24 estimated at Rs.22,316.70 crores and Fiscal deficit is at Rs.39,492.86 crores as against BE 2023-24 estimated at Rs.54,587.52 crores.
