Performance during Quarter I (April to June 2021)

- 1. Based on the above, the review of trends in receipts and expenditure during April-June 2021 is as follows:
- 2. The Fiscal performance during the period April-June of 2021-22 reflects the current economic scenario. The Fiscal Deficit was Rs.25,874.28 crores and Revenue deficit was Rs.21,242.15 crores.

Receipts

Total Revenue Receipts

3. The Revenue Receipts of Rs.30,728.80 crores which consists of Tax Revenue, Non-Tax Revenue, Share of Central Taxes and Central Grants during April-June 2021 which is 17.34 per cent of B.E.2021-22.

Tax Revenue

4. Receipts under Tax Revenue is Rs.15,684.70 crores during April-June 2021 which is 18.39 percent of B.E 2021-22.

Non-Tax Revenue

- 5. Non tax revenue receipts during April- June 2021 is Rs.867.90 crore which is 12.31 per cent of B.E.2021-22.
- 6. As per the recommendations of 15th F.C., the devolutions of Share of Central Taxes is 41%. Accordingly, Govt. of India released an amount of Rs.4,756 crores during April-June 2021, i.e., 17.66% of B.E. 2021-22. The

Central Assistance to State Development Schemes from the Govt. of India is Rs. 3,593.07 crores during April-June 2021.

Capital Receipts

7. The Capital Receipts consists of Recovery of Loans, Borrowings & Other Liabilities and Deposits Transactions (Net) shows Rs.28,203.21 crores against the B.E.2021-22 of Rs.52,582.79 crores.

Expenditure

- 8. The total expenditure, during April-June 2021, is at Rs.58,958.47 crores which is 25.66 per cent of B.E. 2021-22.
- 9. During April-June 2021-22, Revenue expenditure was Rs.51,970.95 crores which is 28.52% as against the BE 2021-22 of Rs.1,82,196.54 crores. The components under revenue expenditure are salaries, pensions, interest payments, subsidies, maintenance, Navaratnalu, Manifesto Schemes and other grant-in-aid expenditure.
- 10. Capital expenditure during April-June 2021 is Rs.4,606.34 crores which is 14.76% as against Rs.31,198.38 crores provided in BE 2021-22.
